**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CLAY COUNTY, IOWA, APPROVING THE FUNDING FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES TO THE PARKER HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF CLAY COUNTY AND THE CLAY COUNTY HERITAGE CENTER.**

WHEREAS, the County understands that economic development is a public purpose for which the county may provide grants, loans, guarantees, and other financial assistance to or for the benefit of private persons; and

WHEREAS, the County supports the efforts of the Parker Historical Society in their expansion and creation of the Clay County Heritage Center and have determined that a public purpose will be accomplished by dispensing funds according to Iowa Code Chapter 15A.1(2)(b); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Supervisors of Clay County, Iowa; will fund the Parker Historical Society an amount totaling \$25,000 for fiscal year 2010 from the General Basic fund.
