

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLAY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING DEDICATION OF TRAIL TO PUBLIC USE, COMMITMENT TO THE CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAIL, AND COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS TO THE PROJECT

WHEREAS; Clay County, Iowa is preparing an application to Region 3 Regional Planning Affiliation for Transportation Alternatives Program funding to assist with creation of a trail that will complete connection of Clay County to the Iowa Great Lakes Trail in Dickinson County; and

WHEREAS; the grant application has specific requirements for usage, care, and local funding commitment; and

WHEREAS; the County agrees with the specific grant requirements

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that all county portions of the trail identified in the application be dedicated to public use and commit to county maintenance of those portions of the trail for a minimum of twenty (20) years from project completion, and Clay County commits two hundred sixty eight thousand five hundred and fifty six dollars (\$268,556) in local matching funds towards completion of the project.
