			<p>Summary: Changes the language that describes a person who cannot legally vote from "idiot or insane person" to "a person adjudged mentally incompetent to vote".</p> <p>Section 5 Article II of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof: DISQUALIFIED PERSONS. SEC. 5.A. A person adjudged mentally incompetent to vote or a person convicted of any infamous crime shall not be entitled to the privilege of an elector.</p>
