

Clay County Board of Supervisors

Drainage Minutes

May 4, 2010

The Clay County Board of Supervisors met as trustees of Drainage District #7; #12; #16; #23; # 48; #98 and #108 Royalty Addition. Members present: Chalstrom, Matthews, Swanson, Brockshus, Skow. Absent: None.

Motion by Matthews, seconded by Brockshus to appoint Supervisor Linda Swanson as Chairperson for this meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Brockshus, seconded by Chalstrom to appoint Marjorie Pitts, Clay County Auditor as Secretary for this meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Matthews, seconded by Brockshus, that the following resolution be adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Clay County Board of Supervisors that there is hereby levied 40% against all lands tracts, real estate, highway or railroads in Clay County, Iowa to raise \$1926 for Drainage District #7; 40% to raise \$4937 for Drainage District #12; 12% to raise \$4987 for Drainage District #16; 80% to raise \$9936 for Drainage District #23; 25% to raise \$4029 for Drainage District #48; 40% to raise \$523 for Drainage District #98; and 588% to raise \$5625 for Drainage District #108 Annexed Lands.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said assessments be so levied and payable upon notice through July 1, 2010 without interest. If paid after July 1st, an interest rate of 5% will accrue from date of levy to September 30, 2010 on any single assessment. Any single assessment on any parcel exceeding \$100 shall qualify for a waiver installment option of three (3) payments. The first installment shall bear interest on the whole unpaid assessment from the date of levy to the 1st of December following the due date at a rate of 5%. The succeeding annual installments, with interest on the whole unpaid amount, to the first day of December following the due date are respectively due on July 1st annually, and must be paid in the same time and manner as the 1st semiannual payment of real estate taxes.
