The Clay County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment November 14, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. in the boardroom with Chairperson Anderson presiding and with the following other members present: Supervisors Matthews, Skelton, Swanson and Auditor Marjorie Pitts as clerk for the meeting.
