TO REQUEST THE ASSISTANCE OF THE STAFF OF THE

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of Supervisors agreed to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement creating the Northwest Iowa Planning and Development Commission (hereinafter called the Planning Agency) and is a member in good standing; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to engage the Planning Agency to provide certain technical and professional services in connection with...

Administration of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
to assist with the Seasons Center for Behavioral Health – Autumn’s Center Project

WHEREAS, Article III.E of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement gives the Planning Agency the responsibilities outlined in Chapters 28H and 28I, Code of Iowa;
