

Resolution 2016-10

Amendment to Agreement Between Clay County, Iowa and Northwest Iowa Planning & Development Commission for CDBG Administration of Seasons Center for Behavioral Health – Autumn’s Center

WHEREAS, Clay County Board of Supervisors and Northwest Iowa Planning and Development Commission entered into an agreement on June 9, 2015 to have Northwest Iowa Planning & Development Commission provide CDBG administration services for the Season Center for Behavioral Health – Autumn’s Center Project; and

WHEREAS, there are two additional required CDBG contract provisions that need to be added to the agreement entered into on June 9, 2015 to be in compliance with HUD Federal regulations for a CDBG contract;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Clay County Board of Supervisors to amend Section 10. Federal Compliance Assurances and the following text shall be added to the listing of federal assurances that will be complied with in carrying out the administration of the CDBG.

SECTION 10. Federal Compliance Assurances

In connection with the carrying out of this agreement, all parties shall comply with the following laws and regulations:

- Standards and Policies Relating to Energy Efficiency Pub. L. 94-163, 89 Stat. 871 Mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency which are contained in the state energy conservation plan issued in compliance with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act.
- Notice of Awarding Agency Requirements and Regulations Pertaining to Reporting. The Contractor must provide information as necessary and as requested by the Iowa Economic Development Authority for the purpose of fulfilling all reporting requirements related to the CDBG program.
