A RESOLUTION OF THE CLAY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING
DEDICATION OF TRAIL TO PUBLIC USE AND COMMITMENT TO THE CARE AND
MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAIL

WHEREAS; Clay County, Iowa is the lead applicant in a joint application with the City of Spencer, Iowa, for an application to the IDOT State Recreational Trails Program to assist with creation of trails that will complete the Spencer loop and connection to the City of Spencer and Clay County to the Iowa Great Lakes Trail in Dickinson County; and

WHEREAS; the grant application has specific requirements for usage, care and maintenance and

WHEREAS; the County is in agreement with the specific grant requirements

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Clay County, Iowa be lead applicant in an application for State Recreational Trails Grant Funds to the Iowa Department of Transportation, and that all county portions of the trail identified in the application be dedicated to public use and commit to county maintenance of those portions of the trail for a minimum of twenty (20) years from project completion.
