

**RESOLUTION No. 2016-33**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE IOWA FEDERAL RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM, COMMITTING LOCAL MATCH TO THE PROJECT, AND DEDICATING THE TRAIL TO PUBLIC USE AND MAINTENANCE.**

WHEREAS, Clay County in a joint effort with the city of Spencer, Iowa has identified and targeted a desire to complete the Iowa Great Lakes Connection Trail; and,

WHEREAS, Clay County does not possess the necessary financial resources to conduct this project without financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, Clay County has the ability to apply in a joint application with the City of Spencer, Iowa for Iowa Federal Recreational Trails Program financial assistance through the Iowa Department of Transportation, and wishes to apply for said assistance for a segment of the Iowa Great Lakes Connection Trail; and,

WHEREAS, The Clay County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chairman to sign any application materials.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Clay County, Iowa commits local funds to the proposed project in the amount of \$66,129; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Clay County commits to dedicating the trail to public use and commits to maintenance of the facility for a period of not less than twenty years from the completion of construction.
