

**RESOLUTION NO. #2017 - 25**  
**Recommending approval of the Brady Follon**  
**New 2400 Head Deep Pit Swine Finishing Confinement**  
**Building Application to the Iowa Dept. of Natural**  
**Resources.**

**WHEREAS**, the Clay County Board of Supervisors has adopted the Master Matrix for the purpose of scoring CAFO construction applications to provide an opportunity for local input, and

**WHEREAS**, a construction application for a new 2400 Head Deep Pit Swine Finishing Confinement Building by Brady Follon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clay County Environmental Health Director, has reviewed the application using the Master Matrix, finding a score of 455 points, and has verified all of the elements of the application for accuracy; and

**WHEREAS**, the minimum score set by the DNR is 440 points.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors published a notice of public hearing in the Daily Reporter as required, and, held said public hearing in the Public Meeting Room at the Clay County Administration Building on July 28, 2017 for the purpose of receiving public comment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, has assembled their comments and those of the public for submission to the DNR;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Clay County Board of Supervisors hereby recommends approval of the construction application of Brady Follon.
