### PROPERTY TAX

Governor Reynolds has signed a Proclamation extending late interest/penalty for the second half until April 16, 2020. Penalty will begin April 17, 2020. Payment options are: Pay online on the site listed on your property tax statement. You can search by name or parcel number and pay by e-check with an extra cost of only 25 cents [www.iowatreasurers.org](http://www.iowatreasurers.org). Credit Card payment is also available with a service fee. Pay by mail to Clay County Treasurer, P O Box 1147, Spencer, IA 51301, being sure your mailed payment bears a postmark no later than 4/16/2020. Payments can be made by dropping them in the drop box near the North and South door of the Administration Building. Mailed or payments dropped off need to include parcel number or address of the property and a contact phone number. Feel free to phone or email for needed information.

### MOTOR VEHICLE

Motor Vehicle renewals can be done online at the site listed on your renewal notice which does require a PIN which is located on your mailed renewal notice. Renewals can be mailed to the address shown above or placed in the drop box. Please call if you need to know the amount due. Mailed or dropped off payments need to include the plate number(s) of the vehicles and your contact phone number. Title transactions can be done by mail. Please call or email and we will review with you the documents and payment needed.

### DRIVER LICENSE

At this time the Iowa DOT State stations are offering driver license services by appointment. Please remember you have a 60 day grace period for driver license renewal and no testing is required as long as you renew within one year. Real ID enforcement for those flying or entering a federal facility does not start until October 2020.
